The contest is held every year by [neuralcorrelate.com](#), and each year they choose top [ten illusions](#) from thousands of [submissions](#). If you remember I covered [2006 winner here](#). "Two images of the [Leaning Tower](#) of Pisa below are identical, yet one has the impression that the [tower on the right](#) leans more, as if photographed from a [different angle](#). The reason for this phenomenon is because the visual system treats the two images as if part of a [single scene](#)".

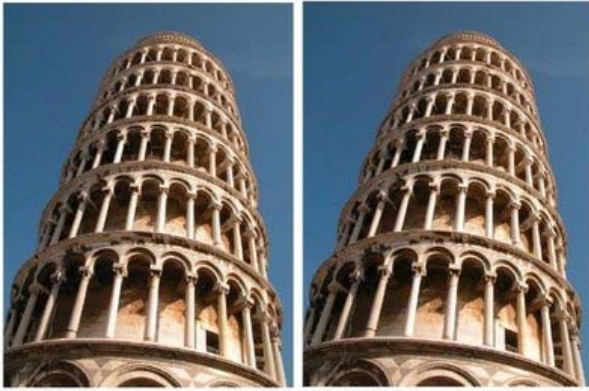
